SAVING YOUR HOME: PREVENTING FORCLOSURE

Facing a foreclosure, or potential foreclosure, is very frightening from both a financial and emotional perspective. It is more important than ever that you are aware of the actions you can take in order to keep your home and avoid foreclosure:

- Don't wait another minute. Seek assistance. *Foreclosure assistance is free.*
- Call 1.888.995.HOPE (4673) to speak to a counselor 24/7.
- Call 211 to get connected to a local housing counseling agency
- Contact your lender immediately. **DO NOT** ignore letters and phone calls.
- Don't fall victim to a scam. *Remember Foreclosure assistance is free.*
